World Teachers` Day

Teachers` Day is a special day for the appreciation of teachers and their hard work. Although the festival is celebrated in different countries of the world, it doesn't fall on the same day. In the most countries people celebrate it on 5th of October. In some countries the day is declared as a holiday and children don't go to school. However there are countries where it is celebrated on working days. Students arrange and perform at school various types of cultural programs and activities. India's teacher's day is different from the World Teacher Day. In India, Teachers' Day is celebrated on September 5, in honor of Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, the second President of India. The 5th of September is his birthday. On the day, senior students in schools take up the responsibility of teaching their juniors, to show appreciation for their teachers. The day is not a holiday. It involves activities many in educational institutior



China Teachers' Day was founded at National Central University in 1931. It was adopted by the central government of Republic of China, in 1932. In 1939, the day was set on August 27, Confucius's birthday. Now more and more people are trying to revert the Teachers' Day back to Confucius's birthday.

Russia In Russia, Teachers' Day was celebrated on the first Sunday of October, between 1965 and 1994. A number of activities are organized in schools, to honor teachers. The celebrations may continue for the entire week of May.

Thailand In Thailand, National Teachers' Day is celebrated every year, on January 16. The first Teachers' Day was held in 1957. The day is declared as a holiday in schools.

Iran In Iran, Teachers' Day is celebrated on May 2. On the day, students offer flowers to teachers, to honor the sacred profession.

Turkey In Turkey, Teachers' Day is celebrated on 24th of November. Kemal Ataturk dedicated November 24th to honor teachers and their profession. The profession of teaching is regarded as something incomparable and sacred.

Roller coasters are in almost every amusement park. Speed, sharp bends, seemingly different gravity, insecurity- makes it extremely popular around the world. I will show you three of them!



This 60-meter high design is the fastest wooden coaster in Europe (and third in world!). Its maximum speed is 120km/h. In 2003 Colossos went to the Guinness Book of Records as the world's largest roller coaster of a wooden contruction. Do you wanna go to the Heide Park in Germany after that? ©





2. Formula Rossa

3. Skyscraper

Skyscraper is a <u>Polercoaster</u>, a type of <u>roller coaster</u>, that will be located at the <u>Skyplex</u> complex in Orlando, Florida. The ride is under development and is set to open in 2018. With a structure exceeding 150m in height, it's expected to obtain the record for the world's tallest roller coaster. Look at it! Pretty cool, don't you think? ©
