Black Stories – this game is for people who like crime stories. You are a detective and you must decide who is a murderer and say how and why he killed.

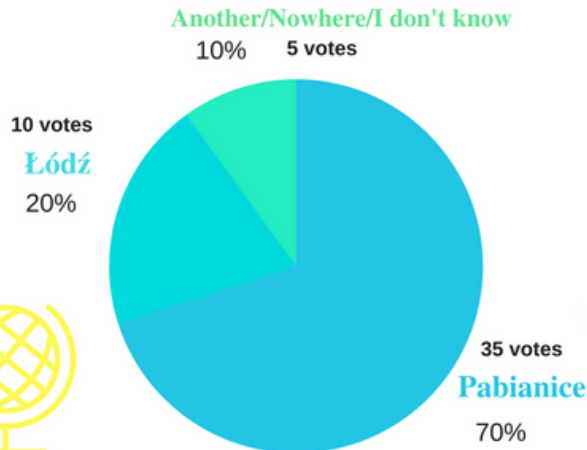
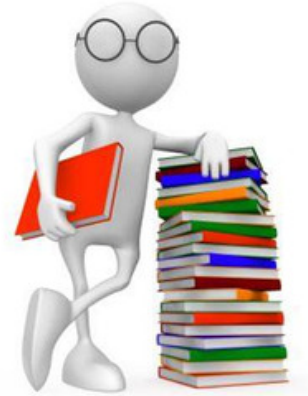

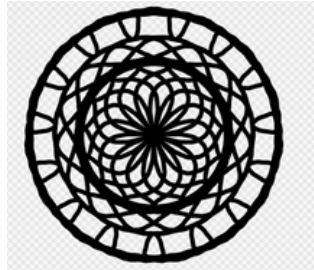
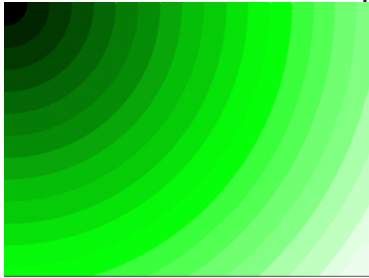
MediBang Paint Pro – Review

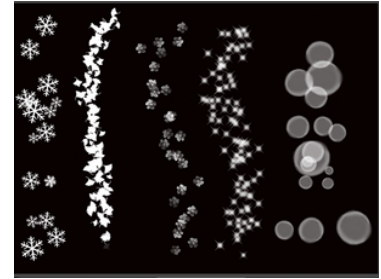
