Best Books To Read In Autumn

Autumn is definitely the best time to read books. What's better than sitting under a fluffy blanket, sipping your hot chocolate and reading a really good book? We have a few books which will help you survive the long rainy evenings.

- 🍁 **"Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone" by J.K Rowling** – Harry Potter's life is miserable. His parents are dead and he's stuck with his heartless relatives, who force him to live in a tiny closet under the stairs. But his fortune changes when he receives a letter that tells him the truth about himself: he's a wizard. A mysterious visitor rescues him from his relatives and takes him to his new home, Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry.
- 🍁 **"Wuthering Heights" by Emily Jane Brontë** – This is a wild, passionate story of intense and almost demonic love between Catherine Earnshaw and Heathcliff, a foundling adopted by Catherine's father.
- 🍁 **"Coraline" by Neil Gaiman** - When Coraline moves to an old house, she feels bored and neglected by her parents. She finds a hidden door with a bricked up passage. During the night, she crosses the passage and finds a parallel world where everybody has buttons instead of eyes, with caring parents and all her dreams coming true. When the Other Mother invites Coraline to stay in her world forever, the girl refuses and finds that the alternate reality where she is trapped is only a trick to lure her.
- 🍁 **"Labyrinth of Liquorice" by Agnieszka Chylińska** –Liquorice is a young girl who lives with her parents in an old tenement house. One day, after break-in to her house, she decided to stop talking. After this accident, every night she dreams about a mysterious labyrinth with puzzling envelopes hidden in it. This is a beautifully illustrated fairy tale about autumn greyhounds and longing for happiness.
- 🍁 **"The Hobbit" by J.R.R. Tolkien** – Bilbo Baggins is living his comfortable, unambitious life in his hobbit-hole in Bag End. One day, Gandalf the wizard and a company of dwarves, offer him a contribution in a dangerous mission. Although quite reluctant to take part in this quest, Bilbo surprises even himself by his resourcefulness
