Eurovision 2018 summary

Eurovision is an international song competition, where every participating country performs an original song on live TV. The viewers can vote on their favourites by sending a message, but the voting system is very complicated. It's either very political or everyone votes for their neighbours. It's a huge event and Europe's biggest party of the year.

The 2018 edition of the contest took place in Lisbon, Portugal on 12th May. It was the 63rd edition of the contest. Forty three countries participated and only 26 of them took part in the final round.



The winner of this year's Eurovision is Netta Barziali, an Israeli pop singer with the controversial, but very catchy song "Toy". She quickly gained a lot of fame, but it came with a lot of hate towards her performance, political viewpoints and even appearance.

Cyprus came second in the contest with another pop song called "Fuego" and Austria came third with "Nobody to love" with great chorus sung by Cesar Sampson, who won the jury vote.

Cracow
