Steps:

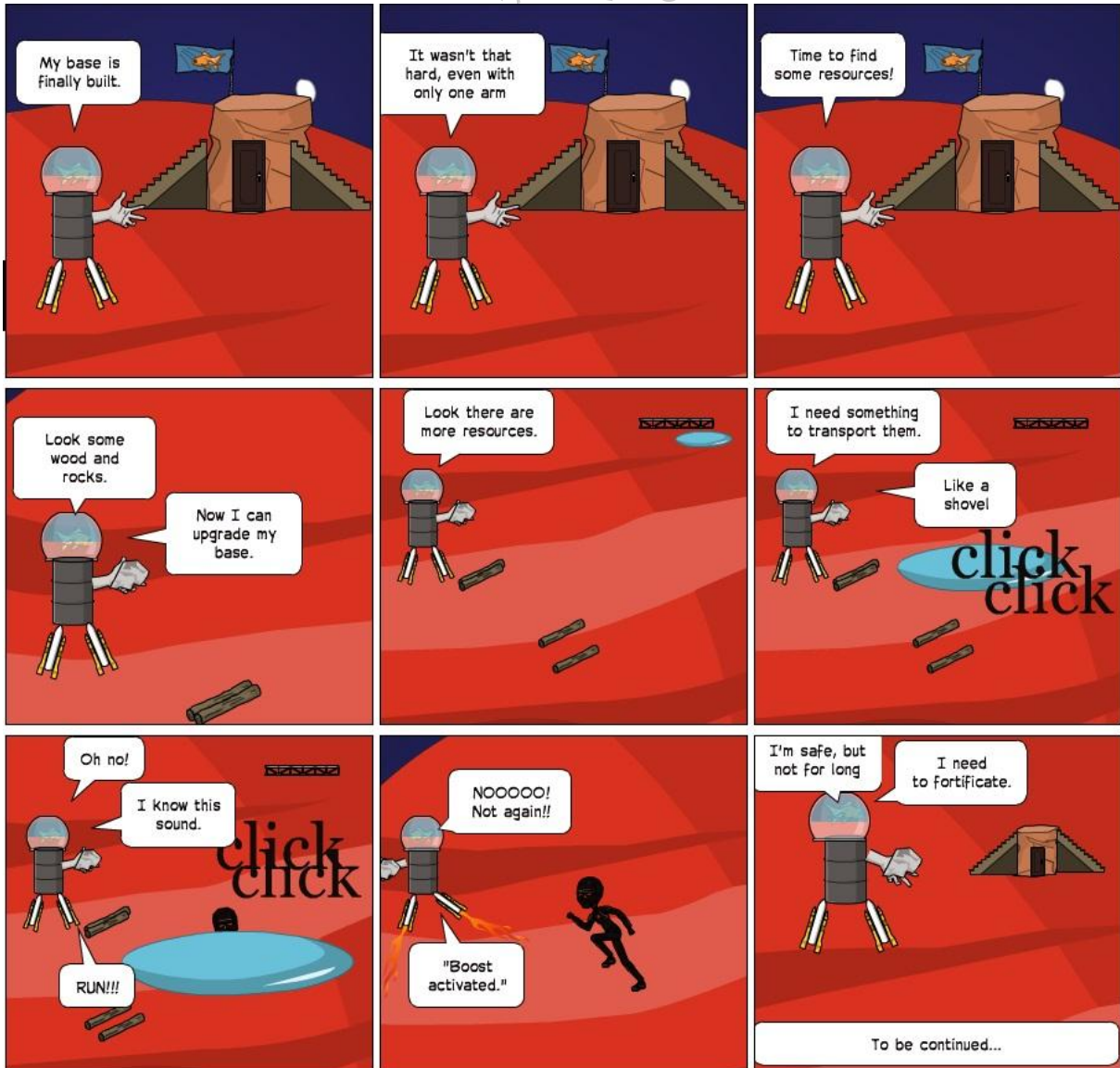
- Cut your paper into ten small pieces and write down all the reasons why you love this unique person. Fold them and put them in a jar.











KID'S CORNER
