Children and parents left our event in good moods with smile on their faces. We hope to see some of them in the approaching school year and we can't wait for the next Open Doors!



and now it's afraid of leaving the nest


there was an African daisy

REVISION CORNER



The most important grammar rules you should know

First of all, when we want to quote what someone said, we can use both unreported speech or reported speech. If we choose the second option, we have to remember about those changes in grammar:

Present Simple	➡	Past Simple
Present Continuous Continuous	➡	Past Continuous
Present Perfect	➡	Past Perfect
Can	➡	Could
Will	➡	Would
Must	➡	Had to
May	➡	Might

It's also good to remember about the proper use of past tenses. Let's have a look:

- **Past Simple**- we use it when we want to talk about something that happened once in the past, something that happened again and again in the past, or when we want to use phrases with 'ago'
- **Past Continuous**- we use it when we want to talk about something that happened before and after a particular time, when we want to show that something continued for some time, or when we want to talk about something that continued before and after another action
- **Past Perfect**- we use it when we want to say that something started in the past and continued up to a given time in the past, when we want to say that something happened in the past but it's important at the time of reporting, or when we want to talk about something we had done couple of times up to a point in the past and continued to do after that point.

And last (but not the least) rule: remember that a correct use of infinitive and gerund is very important. If you choose wrong, you can give your sentence a completely different meaning.

- ☀ I remember **doing** that = I have a picture in my mind of something that happened in the past
 - I remember **to do** that = I have an idea about an action that I'm going to do in the future
- ☀ I stopped **smoking** = I quitted smoking. I used to, but I don't do that anymore.
- ☀ In some cases meaning is the same if you use both gerund or infinitive, for example:
- ☀ I like **studying** = I like **to study**.

Marta' s opinion:



In my opinion, it was a bad idea. Because of it, this year students at my age will have a problem to get to their dream school. Including me! I'm so nervous!
