Interesting facts about our school

Our school was established on 1 September 1963 with P. Sabina Bukies as head teacher. On 1 September 1999 Sp 16 named after Władysław Broniewski was transformed into gymnasium No. 3.

On 12 October 2001 a ceremony was held to name the school after Tadeusz Kościuszko.

On 14 September 2007 we became patron of the Siberian Association. On 1 February 2008 we were awarded the PRO MEMORIA medal.





On 29 September 2009, a plaque was erected on the school building in memory of the Siberian, which is still there today.

On the first of September 2017, Gymnasium No.3 was transformed into Tadeusz Kosciuszko Primary School No.16 with integrated departments


BRAIN TEASERS

World Siberian Day

Polish holiday held annually on 17 September on the anniversary of the Soviet invasion of Poland. The first World Siberian Day was held in 2004.

Culinary corner

Pumpkin cake:

Ingredients:

- 250 g mashed roasted pumpkin
- 200 g butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 packet vanilla sugar
- zest grated from 1 orange or 2 mandarins
- 3 eggs, yolks and whites separate
- 225 g wheat flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda

Topping:

50g white chocolate or 5 tablespoons icing sugar

Preparation:

- Grease a 23 24 cm diameter cake tin with butter, line the bottom with baking paper. Prepare the pumpkin puree it should be thick with cream and slightly warm or at room temperature.
- Preheat the oven to 180 degrees C.
- Put the butter, cut into pieces, into a saucepan and melt over a low heat, stirring every now and then (do not heat too much). Add sugar and vanilla sugar and stir. Remove from the heat.
- Put the pumpkin mousse in a bowl, add the orange zest, pour in the melted butter and sugar and mix. Set aside half a cup of the resulting mixture for the topping. Add the egg yolks to the rest and mix.
- Whisk the egg whites into a stiff froth. Sift the flour into a separate bowl and mix with the baking powder and baking soda.

- Gently combine the dry and wet ingredients stir slowly with a spoon just until the ingredients are combined, gently stir in the egg whites at the end.
- Pour the mixture into the cake tin. Place in the preheated oven and bake for approx. 40 45 minutes or until dry. Remove from the oven and allow to cool.

<u>Topping</u>: Add the melted chocolate or icing sugar to the set aside mixture and mix. Pour over the cake once it has cooled down.



Sour soup on a pig's snout:

Ingredients:

1/2 kg fresh raw pig's head

1 kg smoked ribs

1/2 kg sauerkraut

1/2 kg sauerkraut acid

0,3 kg carrots

Bay leaf, allspice, pepper, salt, garlic (season as desired and to taste)

Preparation

In an approximately 7-litre pot, boil the stock from the head and smoked ribs. Add spices as desired. Cook until the head and ribs are tender, about 1 hour. Then remove the meat from the stock, cut the ribs into large pieces, peel and slice the meat from the pig's head. Add the slightly chopped cabbage to the stock and cook for about 10-20 minutes (depending on the cabbage). After this time, add the ribs and pig's head meat. Add the acid from the cabbage and the finely chopped garlic. Continue cooking for about 5 minutes.





Serve the sour soup with bread©

Watermelon smoothie:

Ingredients:

(4 portions)
600g watermelon
200g strawberries
Lime juice

Preparation:

- Peel the watermelon and cut into cubes
- Wash the strawberries, remove the stalks and cut in half
- Place the fruit and lime juice in a blender and blend to a thick paste
- Pour the smoothie into glasses and serve immediately after preparation.
