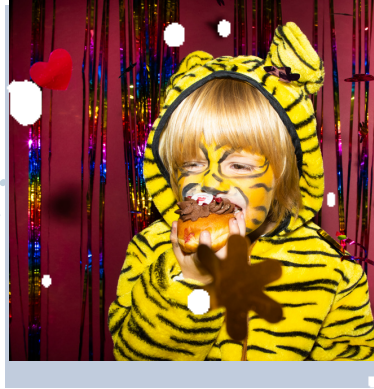

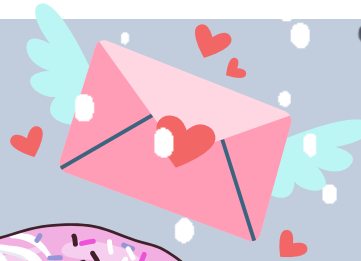

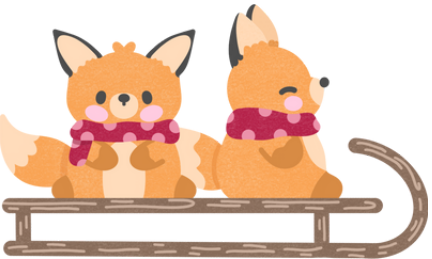

Other popular destinations chosen for winter trips are Krynica Zdrój, Szczyrk and Szklarska Poreba.

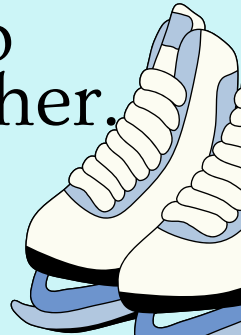
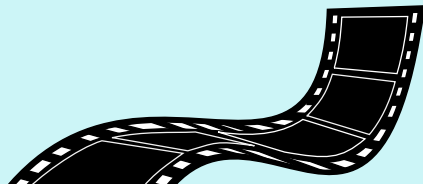


Krynica Zdrój is additionally a spa town.

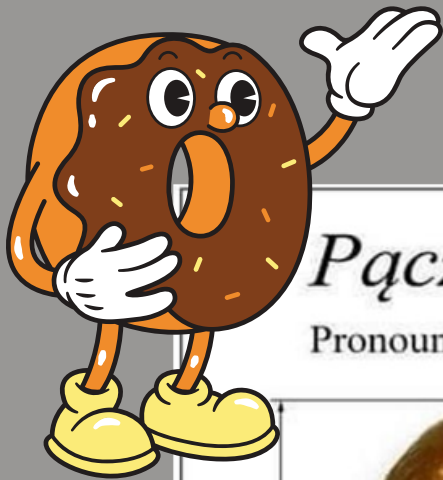
